

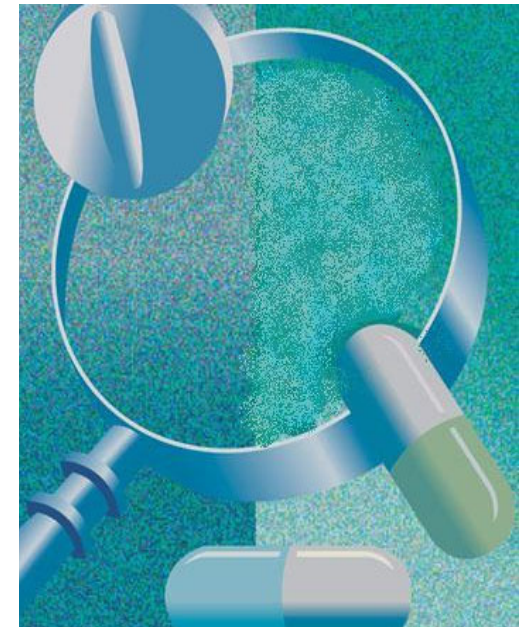
What is the "Clinical Interventions" Program?

It is most cost-effective when recommendations for change can be reviewed by the physician before the first meds are ordered.
